Advocacy by VACSB reps

Below is the final outcome for the handful of bills that VACSB was following, but the final outcome was not yet known until recently.

Below are bills VACSB was following or had as FYI during the regular session that the Governor had amendments on where not all of those amendments were agreed to by the senate and the house. The Governor had 30 days to either sign these bills into law in their current form (with only the amendments the senate and house agreed to) or veto the entire bill:

HB 4 - [Wyatt](#) and **SB 36** - [Norment](#) - School principals; incident reports.

VACSB Position: *Oppose*

VACSB was opposed to these bills during session. Fortunately, these bills are in better form now. The principals' reporting requirements to law enforcement regarding a student incident now carve out individuals with a disability. During session an amendment was put on the bills that carved out students with an IEP. One of the Governor's amendments (that the senate and house concurred on) took that a step further in the right direction and made the carve out of a *student with an IEP* to now be a carve out of a *student with a disability*.

The Governor's 2nd amendment, which the senate and the house did not concur on, was to remove the word *written* in the following context: Reports shall be made to the division superintendent and to the principal or his designee on all 22 incidents involving any *written* threats against school personnel while on a school bus, on school property, or at a school-sponsored activity. **The Governor had 30 days to either sign these bills into law in their current form (with only the amendment the senate and house agreed to) or veto the entire bill. In this current form the carve out will be for *students with a disability* and the word *written* will remain in the bill.**

SB 46 - [Petersen](#) - Emergency and quarantine orders, certain; additional procedural requirement

HB 384 - [Davis](#) - State and local employees; rights of employees, freedoms of conscience and expression. Governor's amendment was in the nature of a substitute: [here](#). The Governor's substitute was rejected. **The Governor had 30 days to either sign this bill into law in its current form or veto the entire bill.**

Below are bills VACSB was following or had as FYI during the regular session that were carried over to the June 17th Special Session. The listing below is showing you what the outcome of these bill will be, although the last step in the process (Approved by the Governor & Acts of Assembly) may not show up on LIS until closer to the Reconvened Session date which is scheduled for Sept. 7th.

HB 680 - Hope - Medical assistance services; state plan, case management service, individuals w/severe brain injury. – **VACSB Position: Monitor**

Enhancement Clauses stated that this bill would become law if the funding for this is passed in the budget. Funding that corresponds with this bill is in the conference report and was included in the final budget.

Conference Report - 304 #3c - This amendment adds funding for the fiscal impact of House Bill 680, 2022 Special Session I, which directs the Department of Medical Assistance Services to update the State Plan for Medical Assistance to include a provision for the payment of Medicaid targeted case management services for individuals with severe traumatic brain injury.

UPDATE: Bill Passed

FYI Bills:

HB 191 - Hodges - Health Workforce Development; creates position of Special Advisor to the Governor.

UPDATE: Bill Died

HB 349 - Tata - Foster care; housing support for persons between ages 18 and 21.

Enhancement Clauses stated that this bill would become law if the funding for this is passed in the budget. Funding that corresponds with this bill is in the conference report and was included in the final budget.

Conference Report - 345 #5c (\$66,521 the first year and \$66,575) is for the administrative cost of providing short-term housing supports to youth between the ages of 18 and 21.

UPDATE: Bill Passed

HB 653 - Wampler - Foster care; DSS to establish and implement a collaborative local board placement program.

Enhancement Clauses stated that this bill would become law if the funding for this is passed in the final budget. Funding that corresponds with this bill is one of the Governor's amendments, so was included in the final budget. **Governor's Amendment #17: Provide funding for foster care and family support** This amendment is a recommendation from the Safe and Sound Task Force. It provides funding for five positions to collaborate with local departments to facilitate approval of kinship foster parents through engagement, assessment, and training of relatives when children enter foster care.

Additionally, it creates a pilot program to facilitate family based placements for foster children at risk of being placed or placed in a congregate care setting. Lastly, this amendment provides funding to develop initiatives to support in-state placements for high acuity foster care children, in order to help prevent institutionalization for high acuity foster children. Funding and positions are provided in the first year only.)

[HB 764](#) - [Krizek](#) - Charitable gaming; registration of landlords, Texas Hold'em poker operations.

UPDATE: Bill Died

[HB 1046](#) - [Scott, P.A.](#) - Over-the-counter medications, etc.; DMAS to study plan for a process to allow direct purchase.

Enhancement Clauses stated that this bill would become law if the funding for this is passed in the budget. Funding that corresponds with this bill is in the conference report and was included in the final budget.

[Conference Report - 308 #6c](#) - Directs the Department of Medical Assistance Services to study options for and develop a plan to implement a process that provides Medicaid recipients with payments that can be used to purchase over-the-counter medications and medical supplies. Currently, certain over-the-counter medications can be purchased more cheaply by a recipient than the amount charged to the Medicaid program.

[HB 1245](#) - [Adams, D.M.](#) - Nurse practitioners; practice without a practice agreement, repeals sunset provision.

UPDATE: Bill died

[SB 473](#) - [McClellan](#) - School Construction Fund and Program; created and established, Gaming Proceeds Fund revenues.
